

CLARIFICATION TEXT

WITHIN THE SCOPE OF THE LAW ON THE PROTECTION OF PERSONAL DATA

The Atis Fuarçılık Anonim Şirketi "ATİS" (VN:1020426770), as the data controller, processes your personal data in accordance with the Personal Data Protection Act No. 6698 (KVKK) and other relevant legislation.

This clarification text has been prepared in order to comply with the legal obligation to provide information pursuant to the Personal Data Protection Act.

Your personal data will be collected directly from you by automatic and electronic means as a result of your registration on our website.

Purposes and legal grounds for processing your personal data

In any event, your personal data will be processed for the following purposes;

- In accordance with the law and in good faith,
- by maintaining the accuracy and currency of the personal data you provide to us,
- for specific, explicit and lawful purposes
- which are relevant, limited and proportionate to the purposes for which they are processed,
- We inform you that we will process them by keeping them for the period prescribed by the relevant legislation or necessary for the purpose for which they are processed.

► When you log on to our website;

- Your transaction security information (connection time, connection end time, IP address, IP protocol used and amount of data transferred).
- In order to carry out the activities required by law and to carry out information security procedures
- Under the condition that it is expressly provided by law in article 5/2a KVKK (based on the provision of the responsibility of the hosting provider (article 5) in Law No. 5651 on the regulation of publications on the Internet and the fight against crimes committed through these publications).

► If you wish to contact us via the contact form;

- Your identity (name, surname), contact details (address, e-mail address, telephone number, message content, subject of communication), transaction security (date of sending, time of sending),
- in order to carry out communication activities
- § 0 on the basis of your express consent as provided for by article 5/1 of the Privacy Code, and
- to follow up requests and complaints and to carry out storage and archiving activities
- § Provided that the fundamental rights and freedoms of the data subject are not violated, in accordance with article 5/2f of the Code, the data will be stored due to the necessity of data processing for the legitimate interests of the data controller.

- **Sensitive personal data;** If you disclose your sensitive personal data in the content of your message, it is assumed that you disclose this data with your explicit consent and that you have your explicit consent to the transfer of this data to third parties. Otherwise, please do not include sensitive personal data in your message content.

Your personal data will be processed for the purposes of processing member registration and login transactions on the Site, processing sales, appointment or event registrations, sending information and marketing content (with the user's consent), complying with legal obligations, ensuring the security of the Site and preventing malicious attacks.

In addition, cookies are used to remember your language preference on the Site, as necessary for the legitimate interests of the data controller. For more information about cookies, please see the cookie policy.

Transfer of your personal data

Your personal data may be communicated to the competent authorities upon request, in accordance with article 28/1 of the Privacy Code, without any obligation to inform you and without your express consent.

In addition, in unforeseen situations, your personal data may be communicated to public bodies specified by law, to authorised persons in the area where the exhibition is held and to our business partners, within the purposes and limits specified by law.

Your personal data will not be communicated to any institution, person or organisation other than our legal obligations that do not require your explicit consent.

Your rights in relation to your personal data

In order to exercise your rights regarding your personal data, you must first contact the data controller.

Under the law, in relation to your personal data, you may

- a) To know whether personal data are being processed,
- b) To obtain information if your personal data are being processed,
- c) To know the purposes for which your personal data are being processed and whether they are being used in accordance with those purposes,
- d) ç) to know the third parties to whom your personal data are communicated in the country or abroad
- e) in the event of incomplete or inaccurate processing, to obtain the rectification of your personal data
- f) request the cancellation or destruction of your personal data if the reasons for processing them no longer apply
- g) the communication of the operations referred to in letters d) and e) to third parties to whom your personal data have been communicated or disseminated
- h) oppose the use of your personal data for purposes that are unfavourable to you, with the aid of automated systems,
- i) in the event that you have suffered damage as a result of unlawful processing of personal data, to obtain compensation for the damage.

You can exercise your rights by making a request to us.

In your application

- Your name, surname and, if the application is in writing, your signature,
- If you are a citizen of the Republic of Turkey, your Turkish ID number; if you are a foreigner, your nationality, passport number or ID number, if available,
- Your home or work address for notification,
- Your e-mail address, telephone and fax numbers, if available,
- The subject of your request is mandatory and information and documents related to the subject must be attached to the request, if any.

Your requests in your application will be completed free of charge within thirty days at the latest, depending on the nature of the request. However, if the transaction involves additional costs for the company, the fee may be charged according to the tariff set by the Personal Data Protection Board.
